I work to help develop self confidence in themselves and with their twirling. Finally, the girls will learn during their lessons what it means to perform. There will be discussions and instructions so they know what to expect when they arrive and what to do. I welcome the chance to help any child emerge from their “performance” shell.

Policies

- Tuition is due the first class of each month. A \$15 late fee will be charged each month there is a balance for tuition or fees not paid by the date due.
- Registration fee is nonrefundable
- A \$25 fee will be charged for checks returned for non-sufficient funds.
- Classes without sufficient enrollment may be cancelled
- There is a two (2) month minimum for all classes. A thirty (30)-day notice is required to withdraw from classes.
- Withdrawal from classes must be in writing and within the first seven (7) days of the month.
- Parents, legal guardians of minors, students and adult students waive the right to any legal action for injury sustained during practices resulting from normal twirling activity or any other activity conducted by the students before, during or after class time.
